Weekly Shooting Assignment 6

Negative Space

The photo assignments (along with the best photos from your yearbook photo assignments) will comprise your Photo Portfolio. Each completed assignment should include 5 photos, 1 of which should be a “portfolio” shot, meaning it should be a shot that best represents you, your skills, and your style as a photographer.

All submitted photographs should be in max quality, JPEG format, in a 2:3 aspect ratio, at 300 DPI. Files should be named with your initials, the assignment abbreviation, and a sequential number (e.g. AMB_NS_1.jpg, AMB_NS_2.jpg, etc.). Photos should adhere to the general guides for quality photographs defined by the course instructor and outlined in the course syllabus.
